

The Big Somerset Cricket Bash Terms and Conditions

- 1) All participants must complete the online entry form and pay the relevant registration fee due.
- 2) Registration for The Big Somerset Cricket Bash closes on Thursday 22 June 2024 at midday or before if tickets are sold out. We will not accept on the day registrations.
- 3) The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable, it contributes to the cost of staging the event.
- 4) We ask that those taking part raise sponsorship or make a donation to support St Margaret's Hospice Care. Although there is no minimum sponsorship to take part, we ask participants to try and raise £50 each.
- 5) You agree that all fundraising from sponsorship and donations are given to St Margaret's Hospice Care in full.
- 6) The walk is approximately 5k and may cover some uneven ground. There will also be busy roads to cross at times. All participants are responsible for their own safety and should only take part in the walk if they are physically able to do so.
- 7) Participants who do not wish to take part in the 5k walk may travel to the cricket ground by car or public transport; transport between the Hospice and cricket ground will **not** be provided.
- 8) Participants will be responsible for making their own way home from the cricket ground after the event; transport will **not** be provided.
- 9) If, for reasons out of our control, this event cannot go ahead on the scheduled day we will endeavour to postpone, and all registered participants will be provided with a ticket to redeem at the Somerset vs Warwickshire County Championship.
- 10) By registering for this event, you are agreeing that any official photographs and videos taken can be used by St Margaret's Hospice Care for promotional purposes. If you would like to take part in this event but opt out of being in any official photographs, please contact us after booking.
- 11) We hope you'll share your photos and videos from the event with us on social media. By doing so you are agreeing we can share these and use for promotional purposes.
- 12) Please note that the data consents and preferences you indicate on your registration will be applied to all team members you are registering.
- 13) Parents and guardians are advised to consider their child before booking, parents are responsible for their child/children safety.

- 17) It is the responsibility of the entrant to participate only if they are medically fit and able to do so.
- 18) Please ensure that you wear appropriate clothing and footwear for a walking event, taking into consideration the weather and course conditions.

- 19) Any participants displaying any anti-social behaviour towards participants, volunteers, staff or members of the public will be asked to leave the event immediately.
