- 1. Participants must submit an official registration form and agree to raise a minimum sponsorship of £70.
- 2. Runners under 16 must run with a supervising adult who's sight of them at all times. 16–17-year-olds can run solo with parental consent.
- 3. Entrants acknowledge they will participate in One Fyne Night at their own risk.
- 4. If, for reasons out of our control, this event cannot go ahead it may be postponed or cancelled. Anyone who has purchased a place will be contacted as soon as this decision is made and notified of next steps.
- 5. By registering for this event, you are agreeing that any official photographs / videos taken can be used by St Margaret's Hospice Care for any promotional purposes.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the entrant to participate only if they are medically fit and able to do so.
- 7. We strongly advise that all participants wear appropriate footwear and clothing to ensure their safe and enjoyable participation when taking part in One Fyne Night.
- 8. You agree that all fundraising from sponsorship and donations are given to St Margaret's Hospice Care in full.
- 9. You must comply with the Covid-19 safety measures put in place at the event.
