

Black Tie Ball 2022 Terms and Conditions

- All tables must be pre-booked and tickets paid for in advance of the event by individual guests or lead bookers. Details for all guests, including contact details and meal choices, must be provided by Friday 4th February 2022 at the latest.
- 2. This event is suitable for guests aged 18+ only.
- 3. No refreshments are to be brought onto Taunton School premises. Ticket prices include provision of a three-course meal and half bottle of wine per person. Additional alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase from the School's bar.
- 4. You agree that all funds raised from ticket sales and activities on the night are given to St Margaret's Hospice Care in full.
- 5. If, for reasons outside of our control, this event cannot go ahead it may be postponed or cancelled. Anyone who has purchased a ticket will be contacted as soon as this decision is made and notified of next steps, which may involve tickets being refunded or transferred to a later date.
- 6. COVID-19:
 - a. If we are unable, due to specific Government restrictions, to hold the Ball on 25th February 2022, we will endeavour to rearrange the event to a later date/provide a refund per point (5) of this document.
 - b. If you are displaying signs of COVID-19 or you have been diagnosed with it, you must NOT attend the Ball. You must comply with the COVID-19 safety measures put in place at the event. A full list of our COVID-19 precautions is available here.
- 7. Guests may transfer their ticket to a substituted guest if they are unable to attend. Please contact lem.cottrell@st-margarets-hospice.org.uk by 5pm on the day of the event to change the name on the guest list.
- 8. St Margaret's Hospice Care shall not be liable for any injury or loss occurring as a result of attendance at the Ball (including, without limitation, any losses resulting from St Margaret's Hospice Care's negligence), provided that nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit St Margaret's Hospice Care's liability for death or personal injury resulting from St Margaret's Hospice Care's negligence or for any other type of liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.
- 9. Any guests displaying any anti-social behaviour towards other guests, volunteers or staff will be asked to leave the event immediately.
- 10. Fire Safety: all guests must familiarise themselves with the details of the fire action notices displayed around the building and note the location of the nearest exit. In the event of alarms sounding, guests must proceed to the designated assembly point.
