

New Year's Day Charity Dip Terms and Conditions

1. All participants must pay the relevant fee due.
2. Children under the age of 12 are unable to participate in the event.
3. Registration for the New Year's Day Charity Dip closes at midday on Sunday 29 December or before if tickets are sold out.
4. Ticket prices are £7 (pre event) for all tickets and £10 (on the day) for all tickets
5. Participants will be able to register on the day, but this is subject to availability
6. Participants are encouraged to fundraise and/or make a donation at the time of booking, however this is not mandatory.
7. All participants who raise/donate £45 or more will receive a free bobble hat.
8. The top 10 fundraisers at the time of the event will be entered into a prize draw to win a free dryrobe advance.
9. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a participating adult.
10. This event is not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.
11. By registering, parents and guardians are accepting the terms and conditions on behalf of their child.
12. The booking fee is non-refundable and contributes to the cost of staging the event.
13. You agree that all fundraising from sponsorship and donations are given to St Margaret's Hospice Care in full.
14. Please wear sensible clothing and bring warm clothes and a towel to change into post event.
15. The event has been organised with safety being paramount and St Margaret's Hospice Care will closely monitor the weather condition and water quality levels. If they are unsafe, the event will be rescheduled for a secondary date which participants will be automatically moved to.
16. The purpose of the event is to dip in the sea, swimming is not encouraged.
17. In the event of a cancellation or postponement, the Hospice will contact you via direct email and use social media posts to update you accordingly. If the weather is poor, please keep an eye on this and expect to be contacted.
18. St Margaret's Hospice Care reserves the right to change the start time at any time.
19. Every participant shall make sure that his/her health is in a condition that allows him/her to take part in the event. We do not recommend taking part if you are pregnant, have an underlying heart or respiratory condition, please consult a doctor prior to taking part if necessary.
20. Participants must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
21. Participants enter the New Year's Day Charity Dip event entirely at their own risk. St Margaret's Hospice Care shall not be liable for any injury or loss occurring as a result of participation in the New Year's Day Charity Dip (including, without limitation, any losses resulting from the St Margaret's Hospice Care's negligence), provided that nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit St Margaret's Hospice Care's liability for death or personal injury resulting from St Margaret's Hospice Care's negligence or for any other type of liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.
22. Any participants displaying any anti-social behaviour towards participants, volunteers, staff or members of the public will be asked to leave the event immediately.
