# Welcome to the Sunflower Centre

We can provide specialist support and advice for patients with life-limiting illness or advanced progressive conditions. The service is for people who are well enough to live at home but need to access the specialist support that St Margaret's can offer in addition to that provided by their normal health and social care services.

## What we can offer

The Sunflower Centre provides a holistic service, helping meet your physical, emotional and social needs. Our enabling approach helps build coping strategies, maximise independence and improve quality of life.

When you first visit the Sunflower Centre you will have the opportunity to meet with one of our team on an individual basis. We will work with you to form a plan and set realistic goals. Attendance depends on your individual needs and agreed plan.

The types of support provided may include:



The Sunflower Centre is a time limited service. On discharge, we will work with you to refer onto other St Margaret's services or external services if appropriate. You may wish to be accompanied by a family member, carer or friend when attending the Sunflower Centre, however the team are able to be flexible and ensure adjustments can be made to support your independent visit. Support for carers and family members is available from other St Margaret's services if required.
