

Hospice to Hospice Ultra Hike - 21st September 2025

Terms and Conditions

- 1) All participants must pay the relevant registration fee due.
- 2) Online Registration for the Ultra Hike closes on Thursday 11 September 2025, or earlier if tickets are sold out.
- 3) The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable, it contributes to the cost of staging the event.
- 4) We ask that those taking part raise sponsorship in aid of St Margaret's Hospice Care. We recommend a fundraising target of £300 per person.
- 5) You agree that all fundraising from sponsorship and donations are given to St Margaret's Hospice Care in full.
- 6) If, for reasons out of our control, this event cannot go ahead it may be postponed or cancelled. Anyone who has purchased a ticket will be contacted as soon as this decision is made and notified of next steps.
- 7) The Hike is **self navigated** and won't be signposted. You will be provided with a Strava link, maps and step by step instructions to help you navigate. There will also be volunteer marshalls and back walkers.
- 8) The Hike is not a race and won't be timed.
- 9) Lone walking is not permitted and if you register individually, you will be asked to form a pair or small group with other individuals for your own safety.
- 10) St Margaret's Hospice Care has taken all reasonable steps to eliminate the chance of injury but there is a certain minimal risk in every activity and you should withdraw from the event if you have any doubts. St Margaret's Hospice Care, its employees, agents and volunteers accept no liability whatsoever to participants or spectators in respect of any loss, damage or personal injury which may be sustained in the course of this event other than personal injury (including death) caused by our negligence. Liability cannot be accepted for any damage, injury or loss arising from the negligence of participants (whether through failure to observe the rules of the event or otherwise).
- 11) By registering for this event, you are agreeing that any official photographs and videos taken can be used by St Margaret's Hospice Care for promotional purposes. If you would like to take part in this event but opt out of being in any official photographs, please contact us after booking.
- 12) We hope you'll share your photos and videos from the event with us on social media. By doing so you are agreeing we can share these and use for promotional purposes.
- 13) Please note that the data consents and preferences you indicate on your registration will be applied to all team members you are registering.
- 14) This event is unsuitable for any children under the age of 16.
- 15) Any children between the ages of 16 and 18 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult.
- 16) Participants must be in good physical health and have no medical conditions that could be aggravated by their participation in this event. It is the responsibility of the entrant to participate only if you are fit and able to do so.





- 17) Unfortunately, the route is not wheelchair accessible.
- 18) We do not recommend that dogs take part due to the hiking distance involved, particularly in the event of hot weather. If you do decide to bring your dog, they are your responsibility. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and cleaned up after.
- 19) Please be aware that there may be livestock on the route, such as cows, horses and sheep. Please consider this when deciding whether to bring your dog.
- 20) Any participants displaying any anti-social behaviour towards participants, volunteers, staff or members of the public will be asked to leave the event immediately.

- 22) There is a mandatory kit list required for participants and it is your responsibility to ensure you have all of these items for your own safety.
- 23) You will need to walk at an average speed of 3 miles per hour in order to complete the course within the timeframe. There will be cut-off times for reaching each checkpoint. If you don't reach the checkpoints in time, you may be asked to withdraw from the event for your own safety.
- 24) You'll be issued with a bib number which you must complete with your emergency contact details, and wear for the duration of the hike.
