What We Offer

We provide **emotional, practical, and social advice and support** to patients, their families and carers during challenging times. We can help find practical solutions and emotional support tailored to your needs. Contact may be in person, online or by telephone. These are some of the ways the team can help:

Supporting People at Risk

- Practical help and emotional support for those in vulnerable situations
- Advocacy and liaison with external services.
- Safeguarding concerns.

Supporting Carers

- Help carers identify and prioritise their own support needs
- Guidance and reassurance for carers managing daily responsibilities
- Help navigating care pathways and funding options.

Financial and Legal Signposting

- Signposting you for advice on benefit enquiries and grant applications
- Signposting for wills and related legal matters.

Housing and Care Options

- Signposting with regards to housing concerns
- Information on home care and nursing home choices (Guidance on care pathways, whether under the £23,250 threshold or self-funding).

Health and Care Assessments

- Assistance with Continuing Healthcare (CHC) checklist and assessment application.
